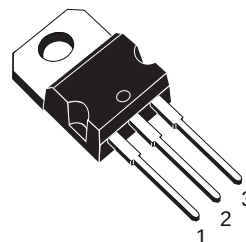

The D45H5, D45H8 and D45H11 are silicon multiepitaxial planar PNP transistors mounted in Jedec TO-220 plastic package.

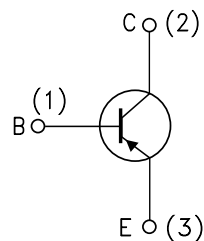
They are intended for various switching and general purpose applications.

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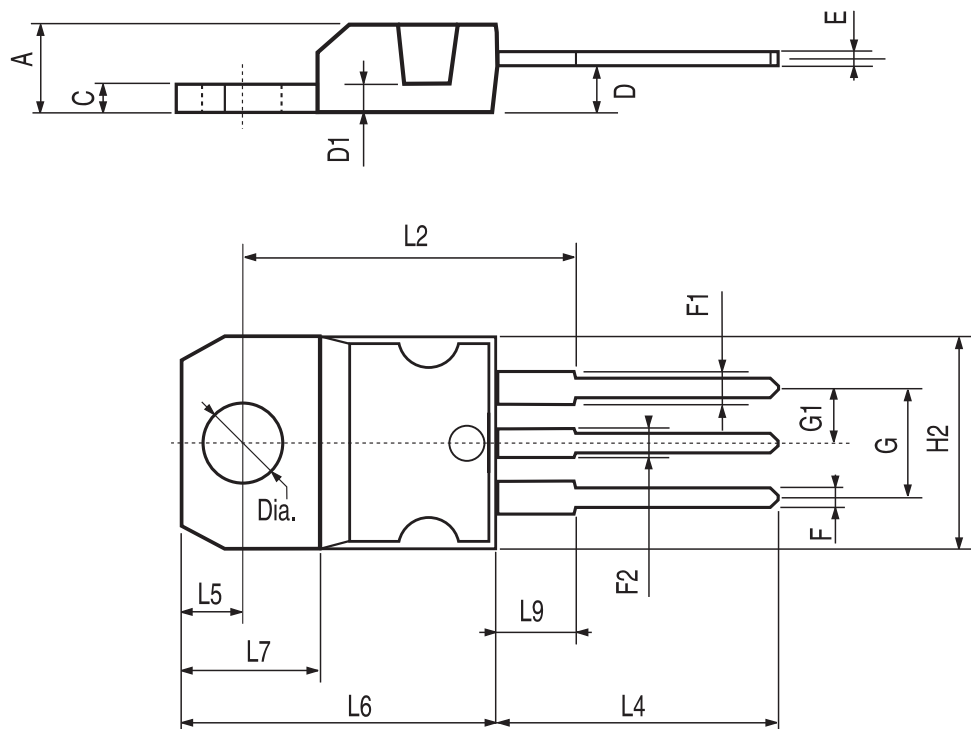
