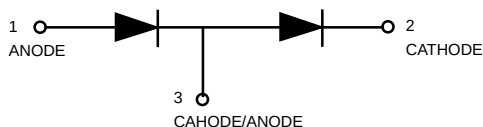
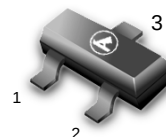

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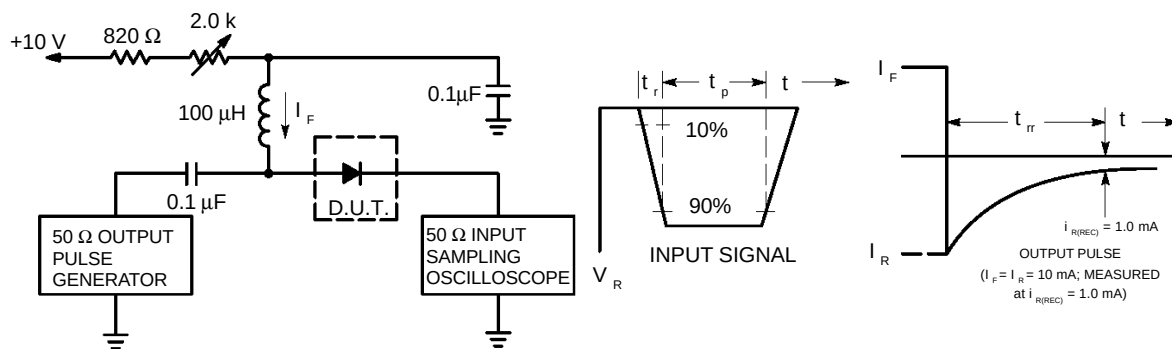

CURVES APPLICABLE TO EACH DIODE

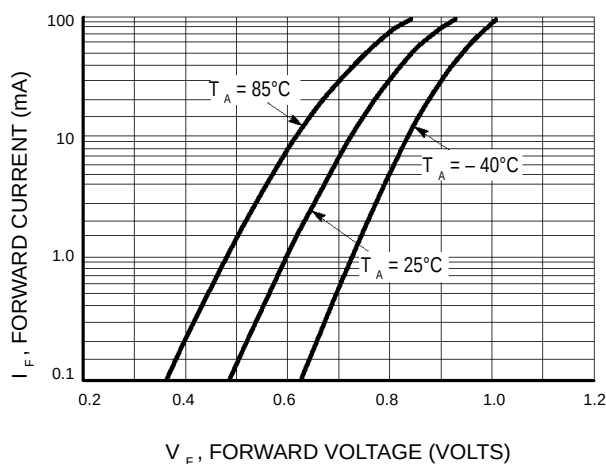


Figure 2. Forward Voltage

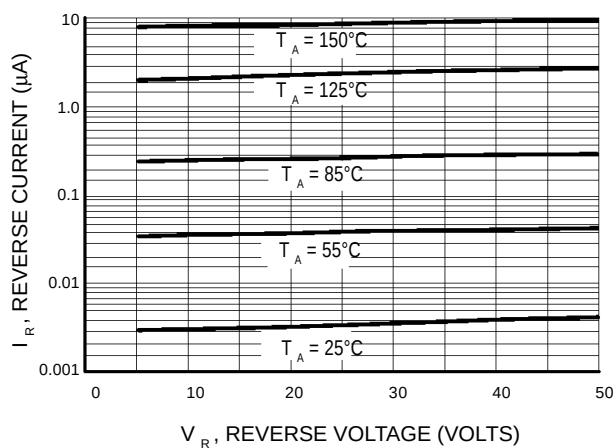


Figure 3. Leakage Current

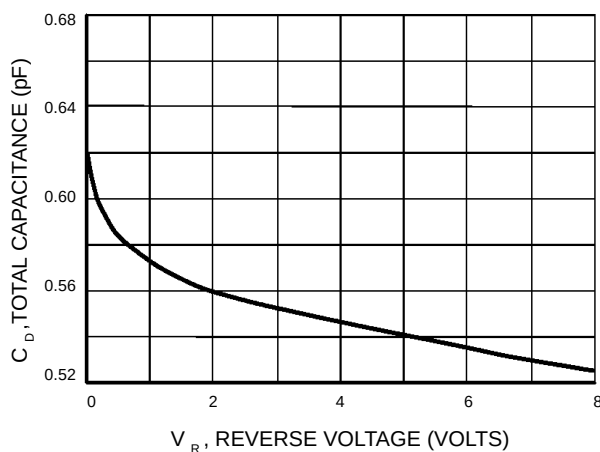


Figure 4. Capacitance
