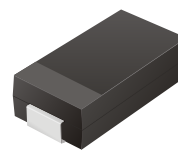

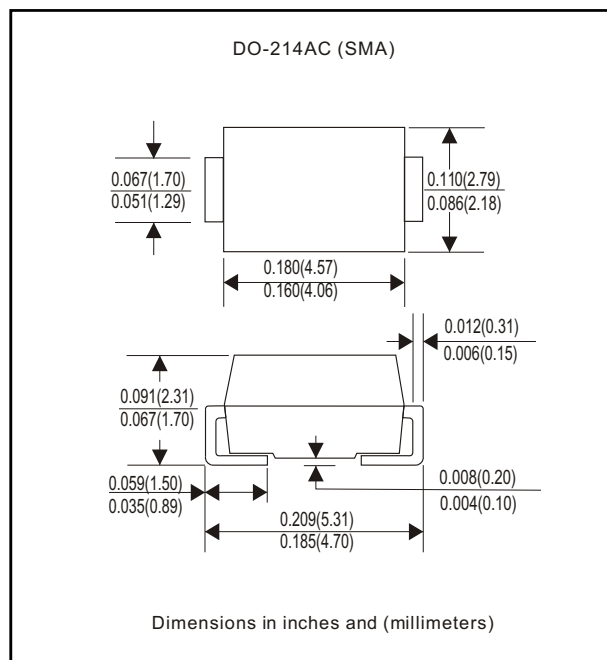

Fig. 1 - Reverse Characteristics

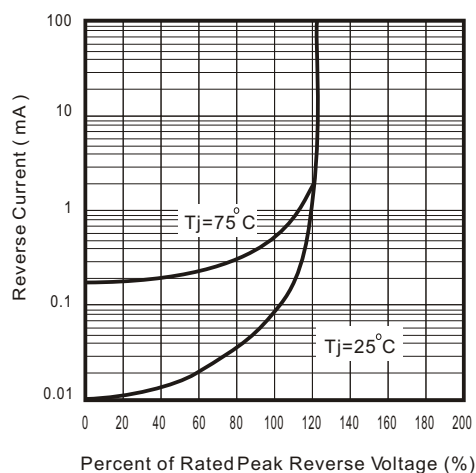


Fig.2 - Forward Characteristics

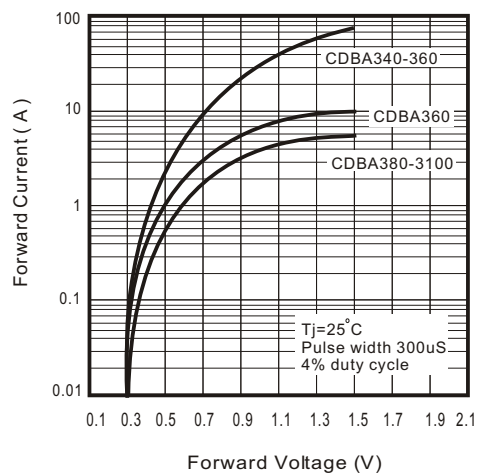


Fig. 3 - Junction Capacitance

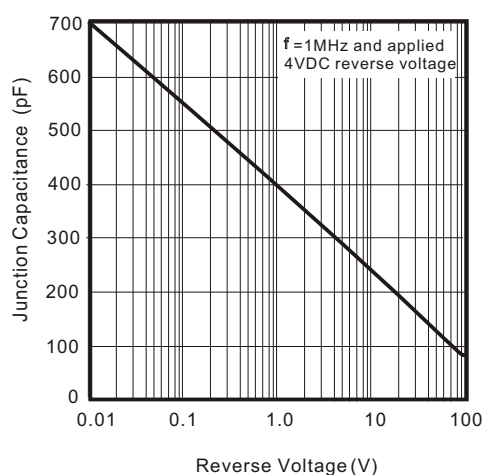


Fig. 4 - Current Derating Curve

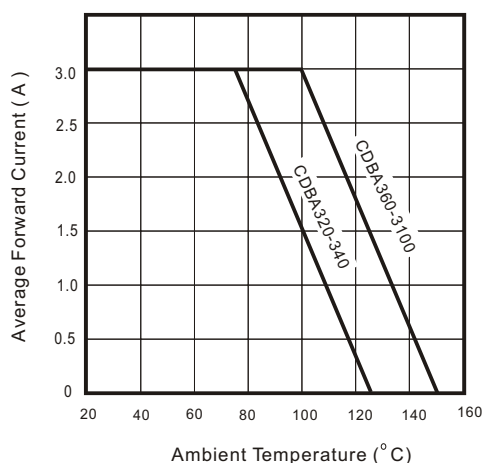


Fig. 5 - Non-Repetitive Forward Surge Current
