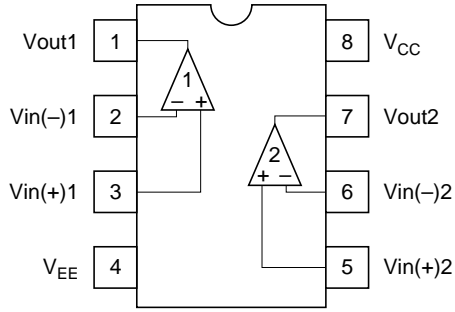

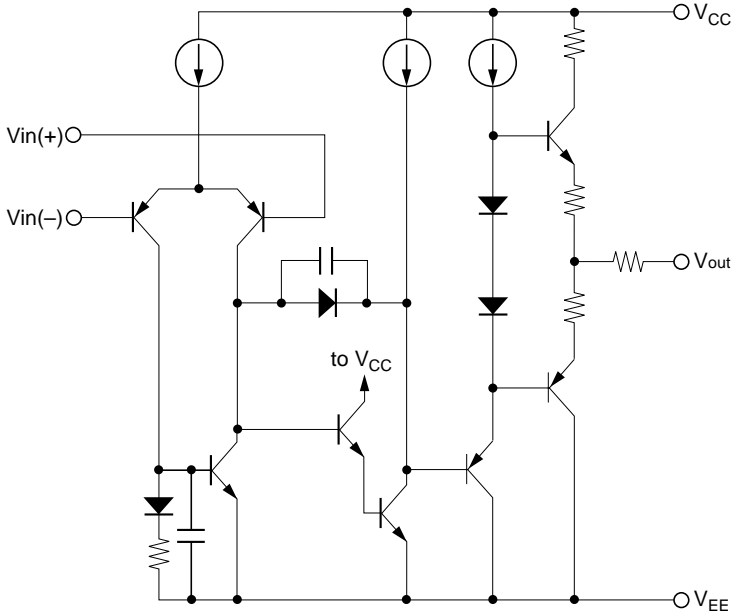

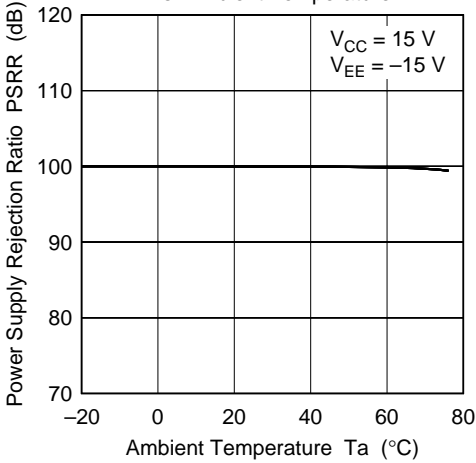
Open Loop Voltage Gain vs. Frequency



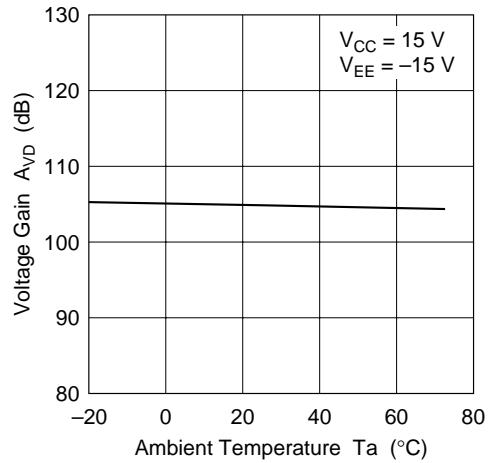
Maximum Output Voltage vs. Frequency



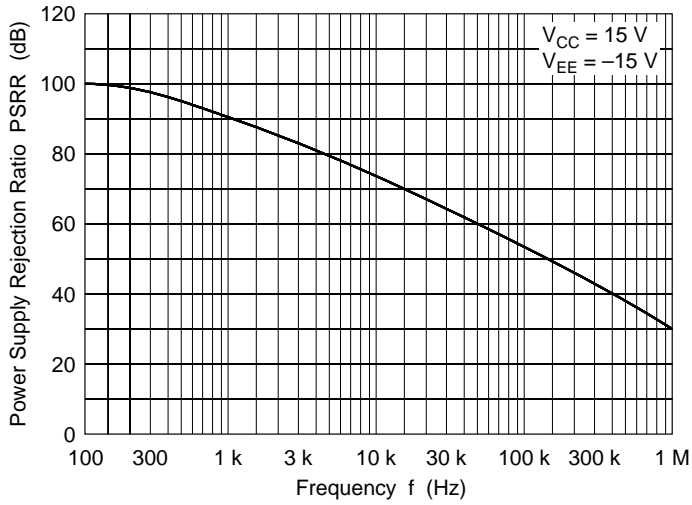
Power Supply Rejection Ratio vs. Ambient Temperature



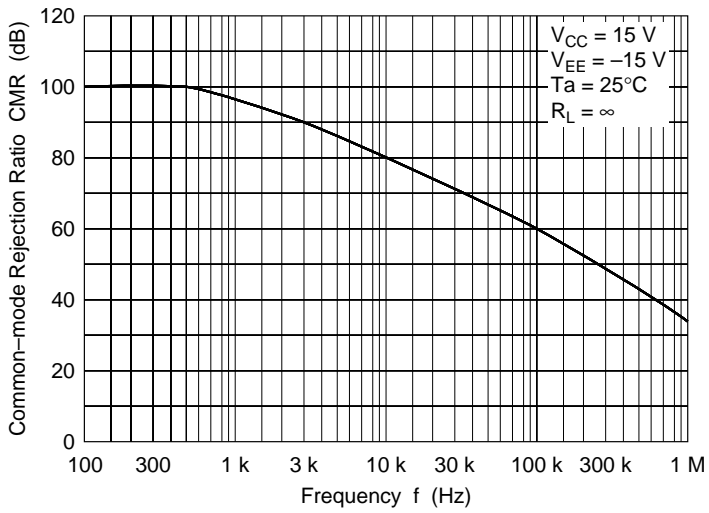
Voltage Gain vs. Ambient Temperature

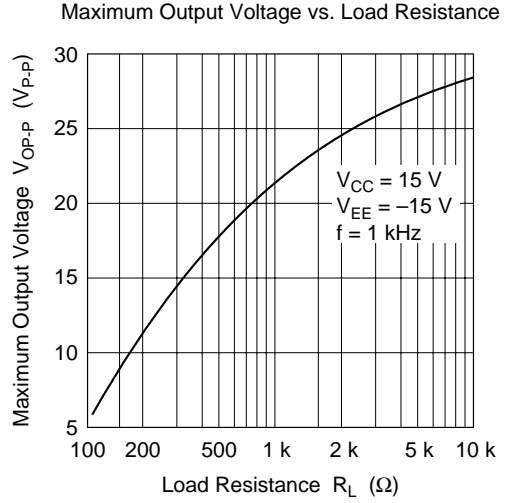
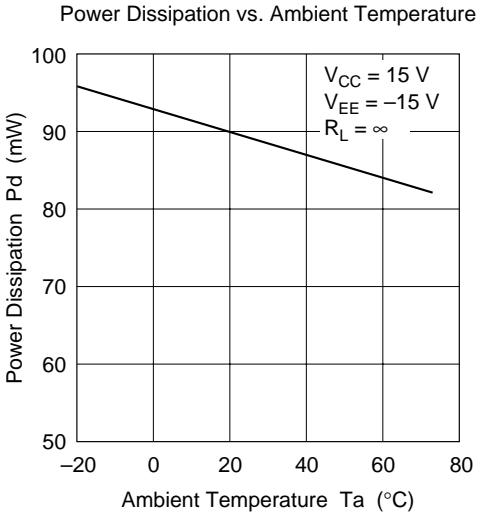
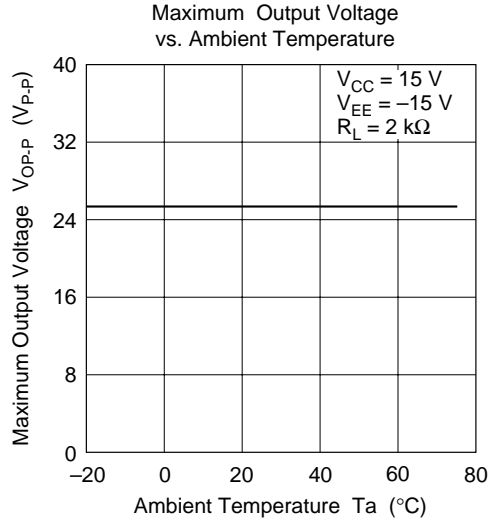
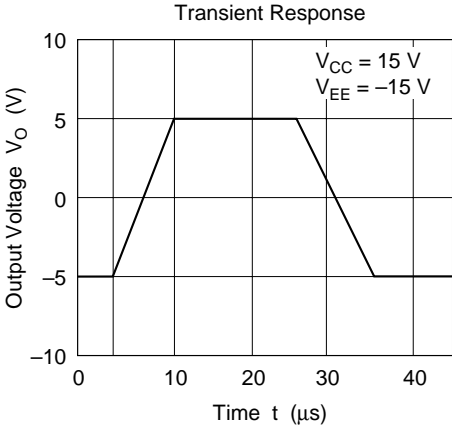


Power Supply Rejection Ratio vs. Frequency

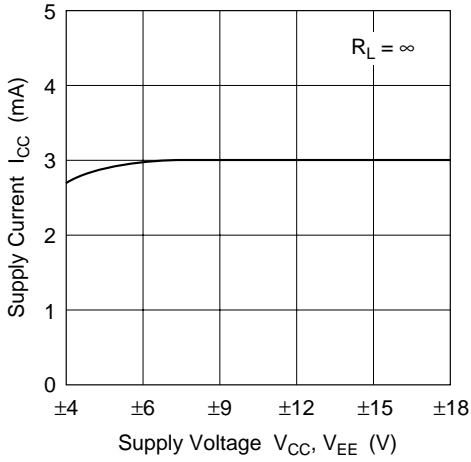


Common-mode Rejection Ratio vs. Frequency

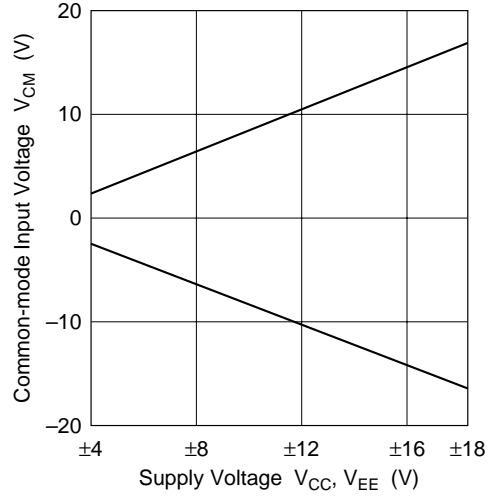




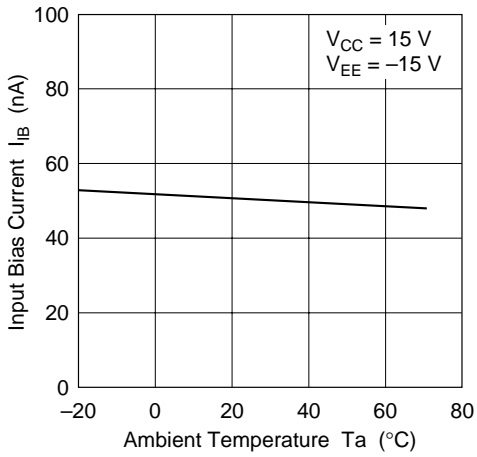
Supply Current vs. Supply Voltage



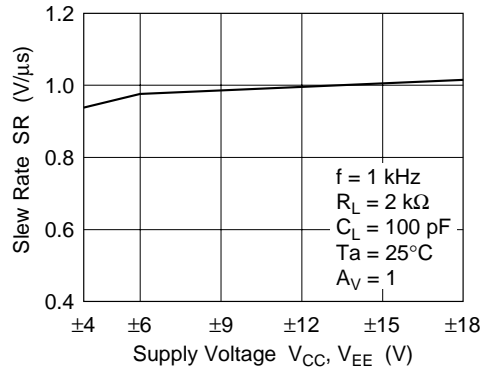
Common-mode Input Voltage vs. Supply Voltage



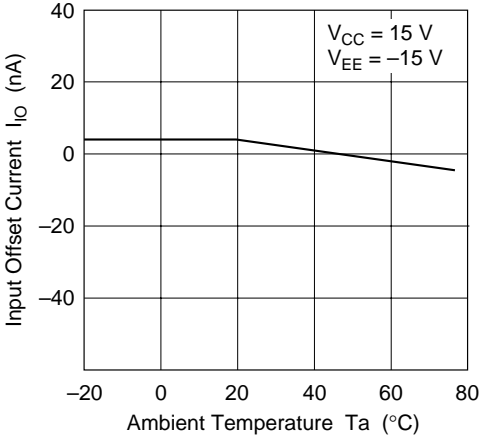
Input Bias Current vs. Ambient Temperature



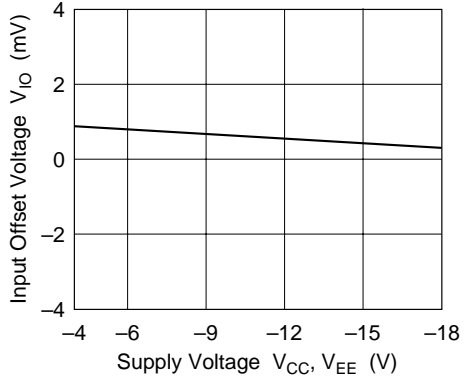
Slew Rate vs. Supply Voltage



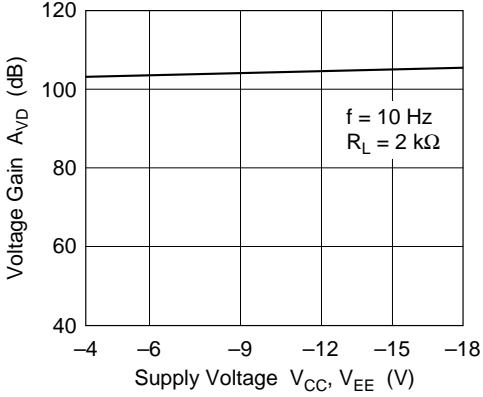
Input Offset Current vs. Ambient Temperature



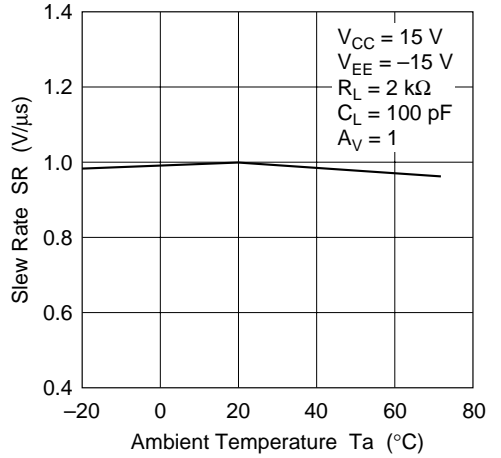
Input Offset Voltage vs. Supply Voltage

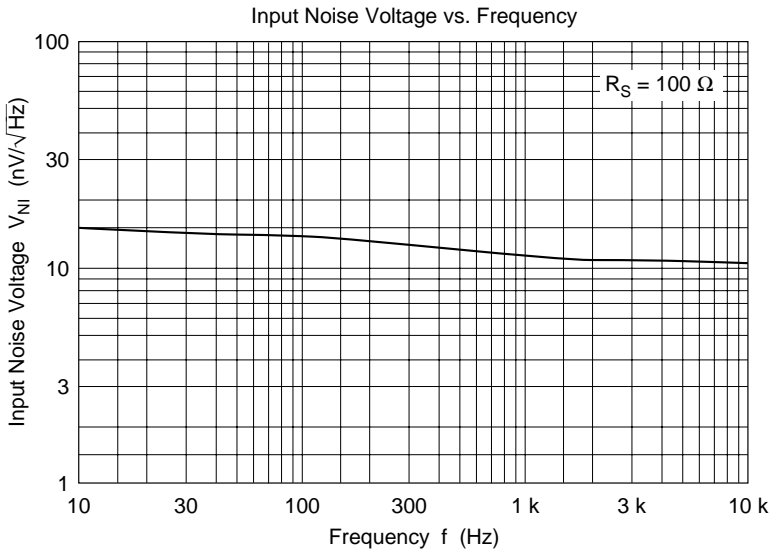
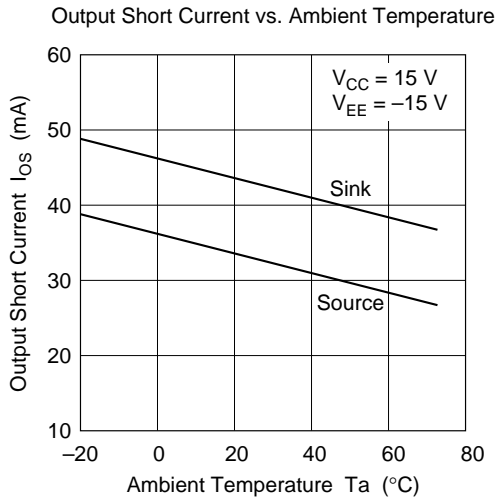


Voltage Gain vs. Supply Voltage

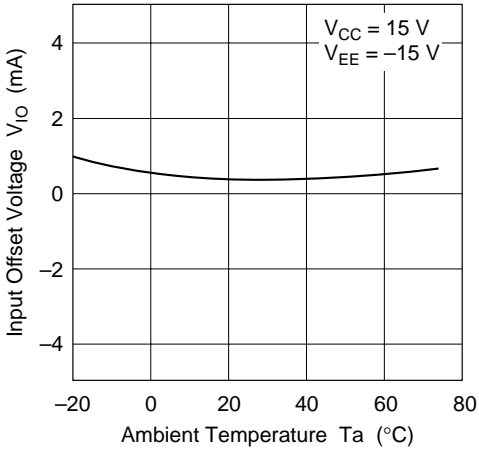


Slew Rate vs. Ambient Temperature

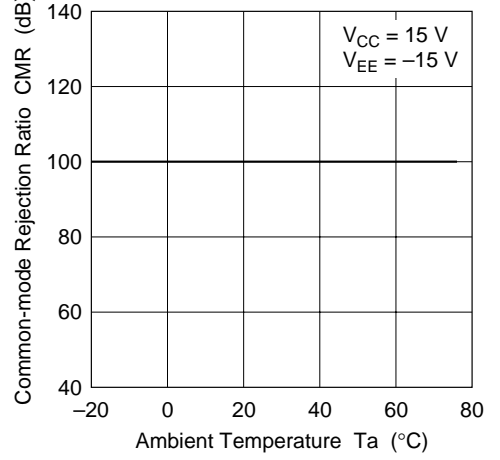




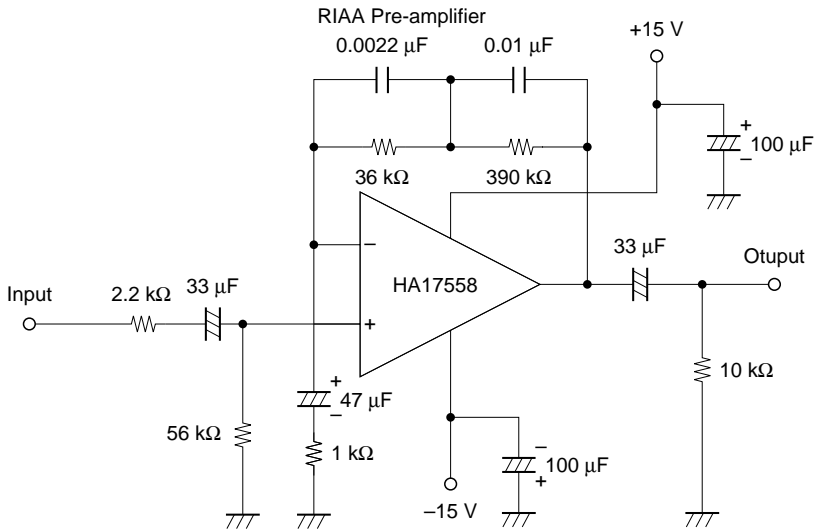
Input Offset Voltage vs. Ambient Temperature



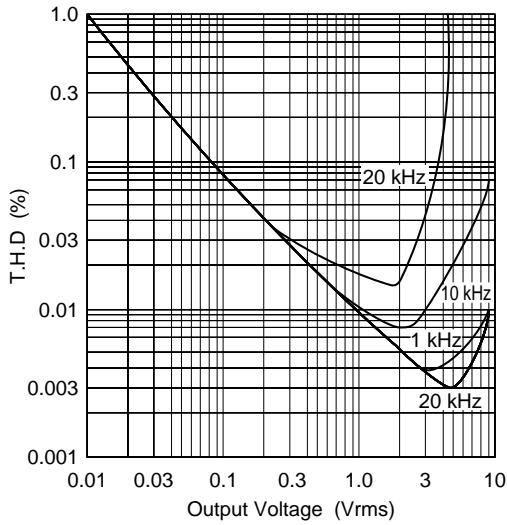
Common-mode Rejection Ratio vs. Ambient Temperature



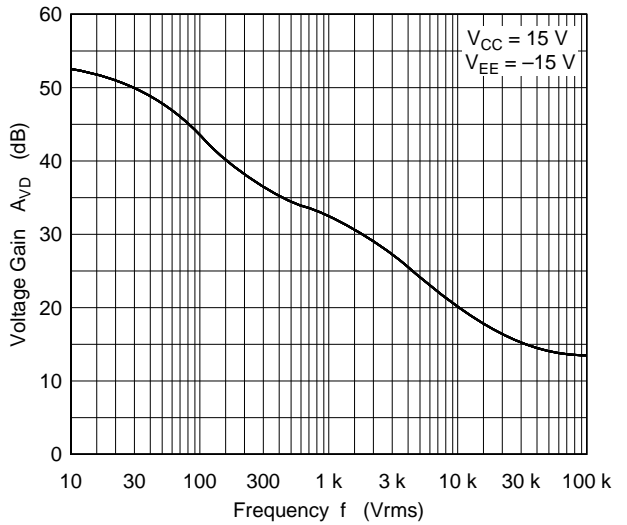

T.H.D. vs. Output Voltage (RIAA Pre-Amp)

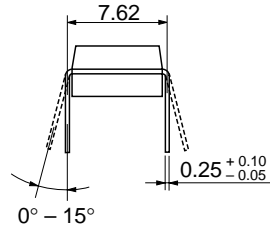
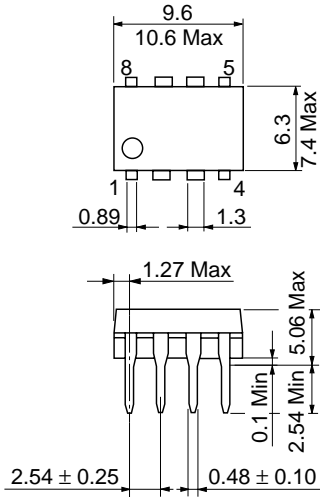


T.H.D. vs. Output Voltage (RIAA Pre-Amp)



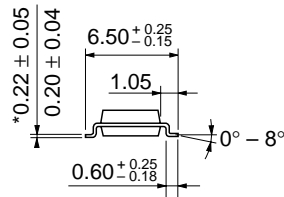
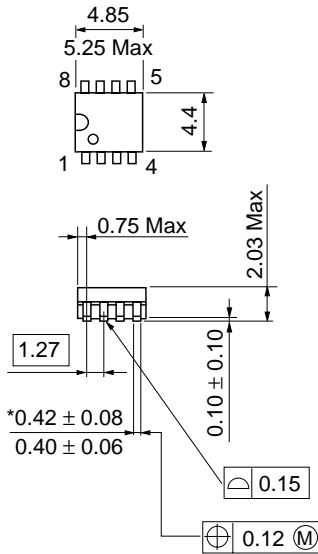
