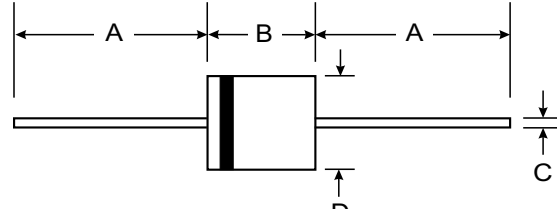

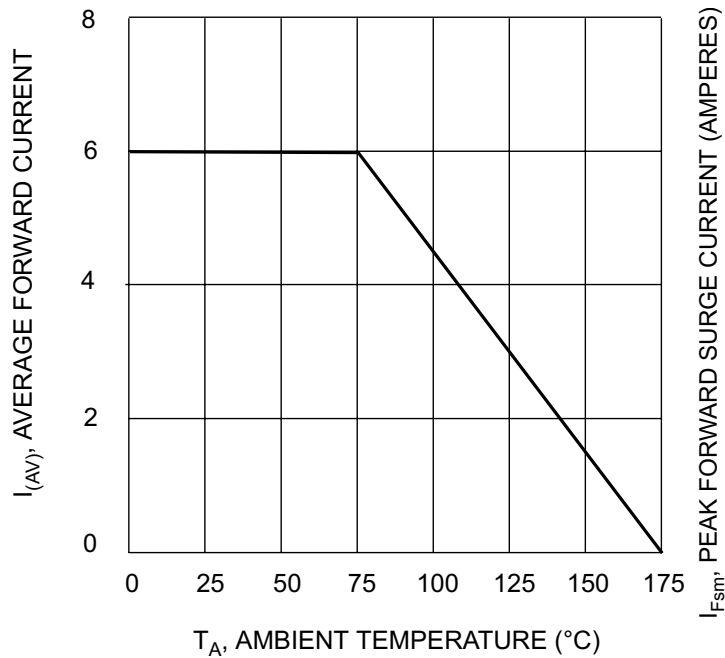


Fig. 1, Typical Forward Current Derating Curve

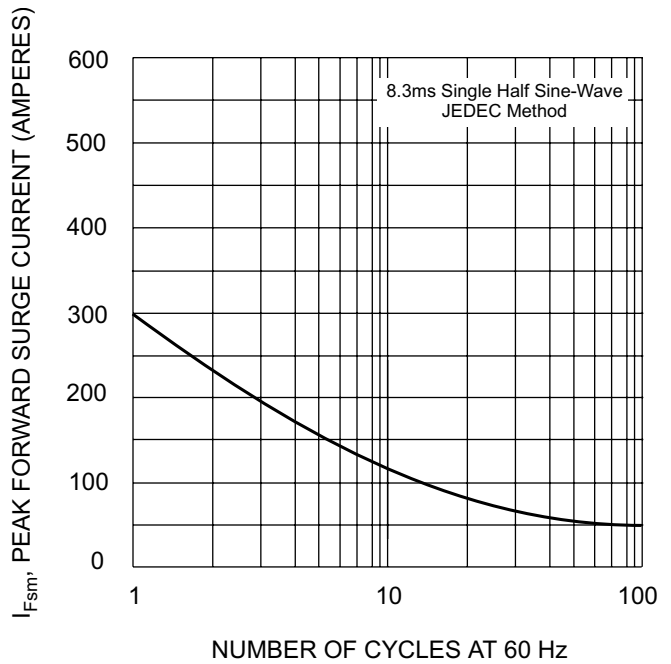


Fig. 2, Max Non-Repetitive Peak Surge Current

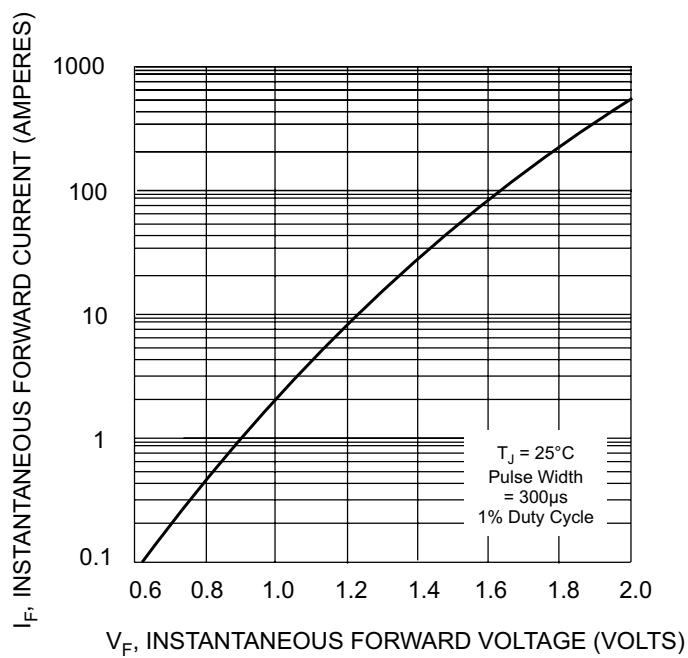


Fig. 3, Typical Instantaneous Forward Characteristics

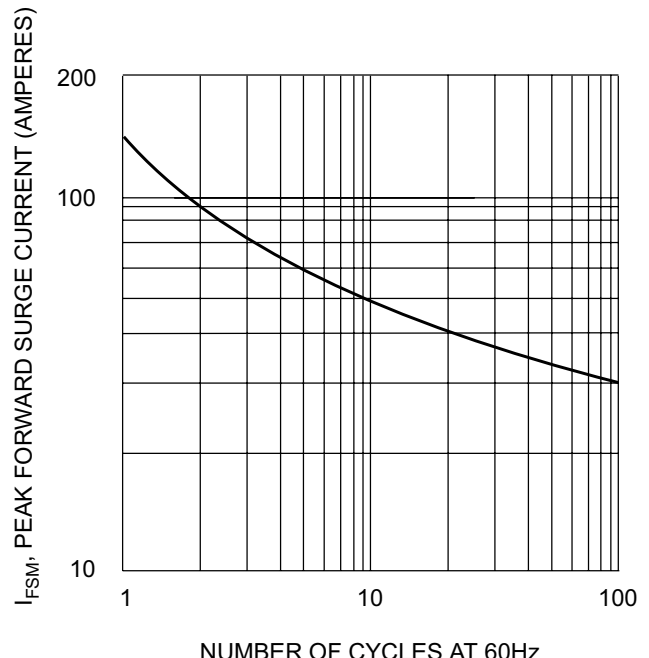


Fig. 4, Maximum Non-Repetitive Surge Current
