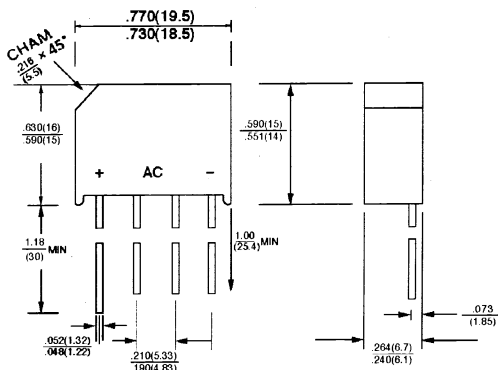

FORWARD SURGE CURRENT - PER ELEMENT

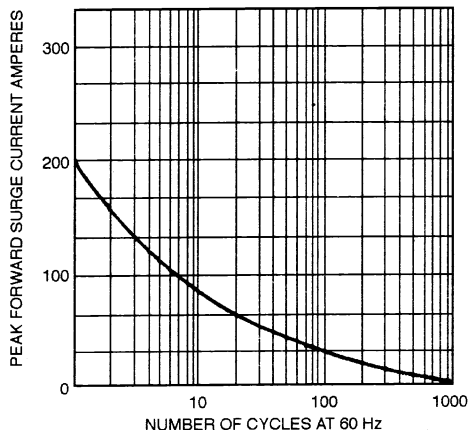


FIG. 2-TYPICAL FORWARD OUTPUT
CURRENT DERATING CURVE

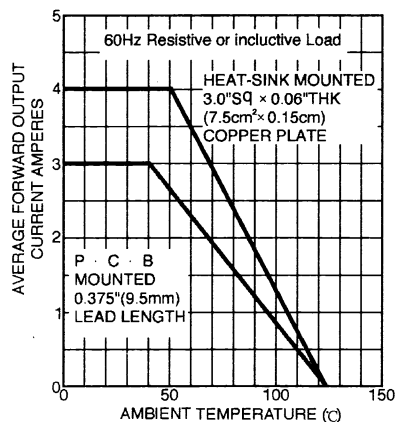


FIG. 3-TYPICAL FORWARD
CHARACTERISTICS - PER ELEMENT

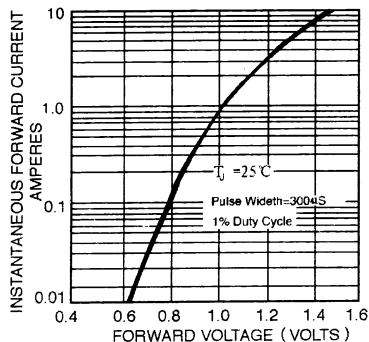


FIG. 4-TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS
