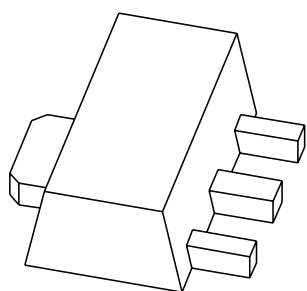

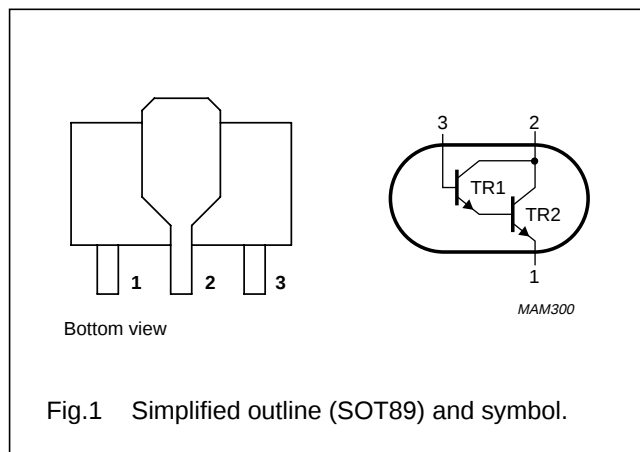
NPN small-signal Darlington transistor in a surface mount SOT89 plastic package. PNP complements: BCV28 and BCV48.

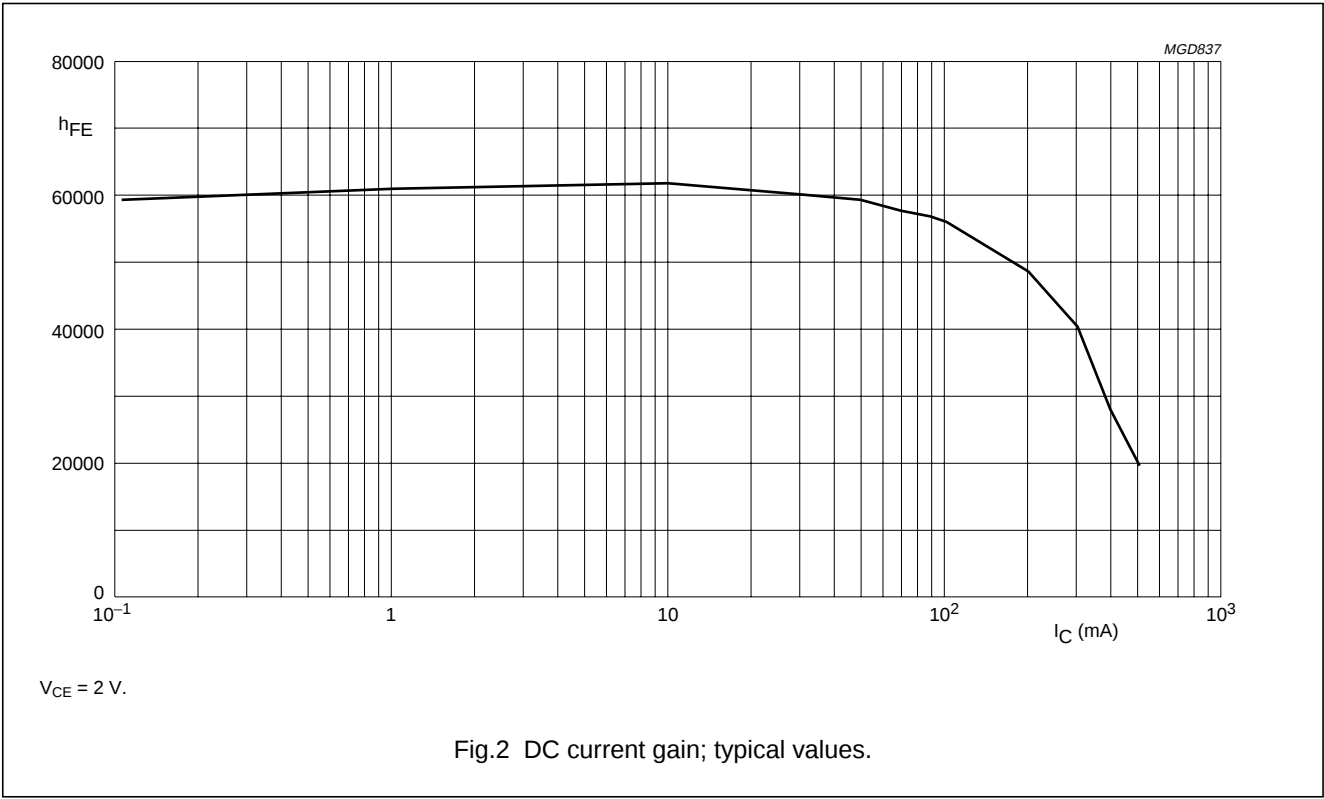

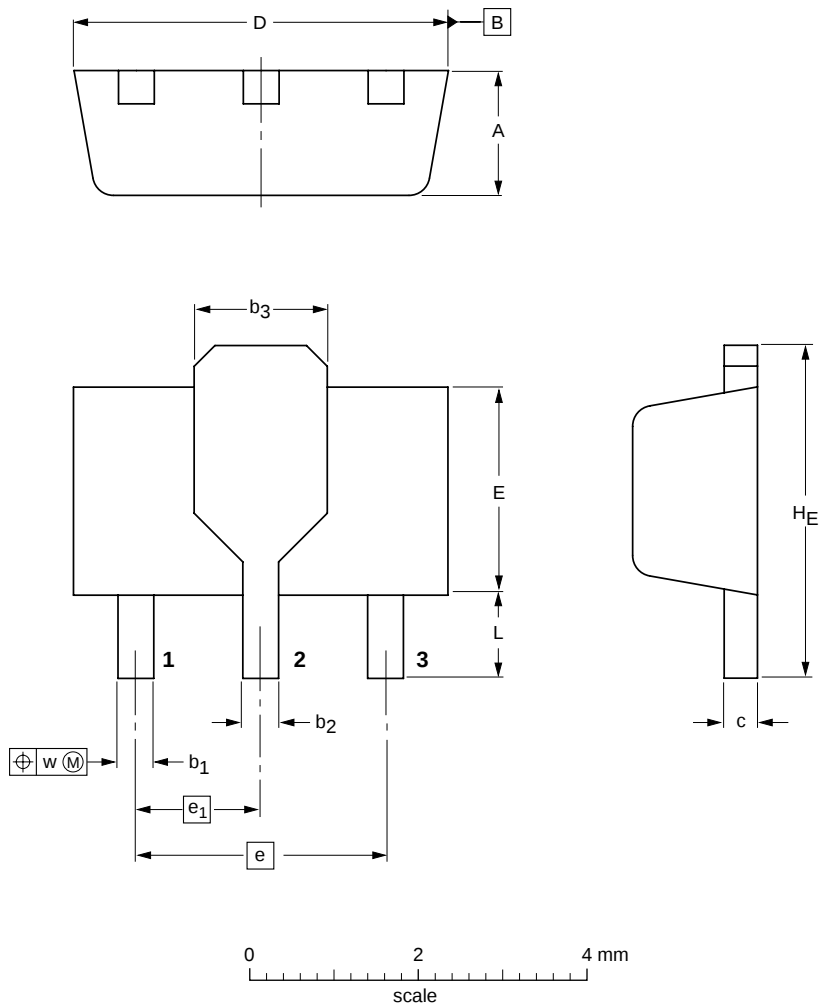
