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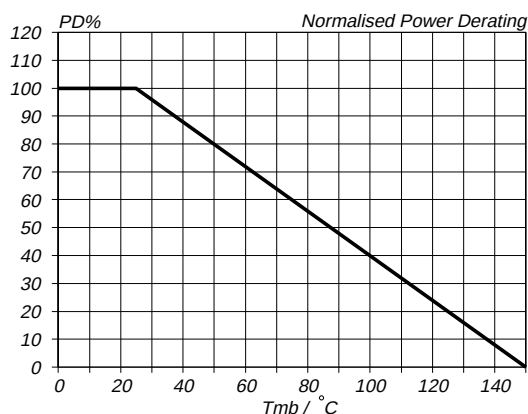


Fig. 7. Normalised power dissipation.
 $PD\% = 100 \cdot PD / PD_{25^\circ C} = f(T_{mb})$

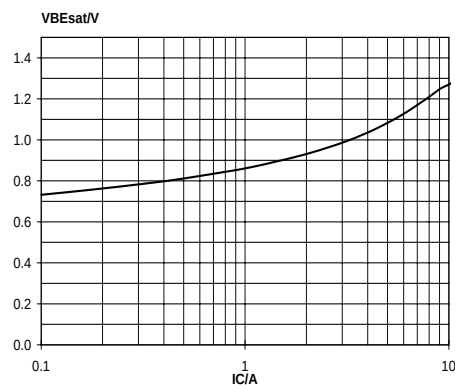


Fig. 10. Base-Emitter saturation voltage.
 Solid lines = typ values, $V_{BE(sat)} = f(I_C)$; at $I_C/I_B = 4$.

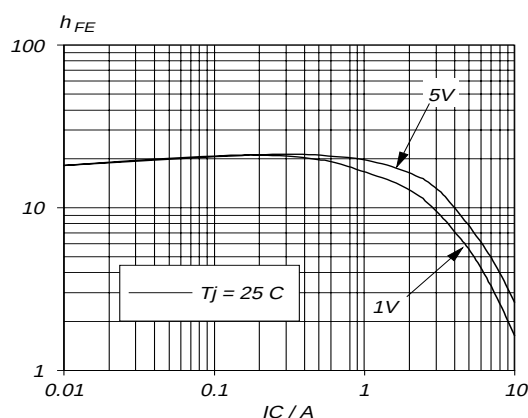


Fig. 8. Typical DC current gain. $h_{FE} = f(I_C)$
 parameter V_{CE}

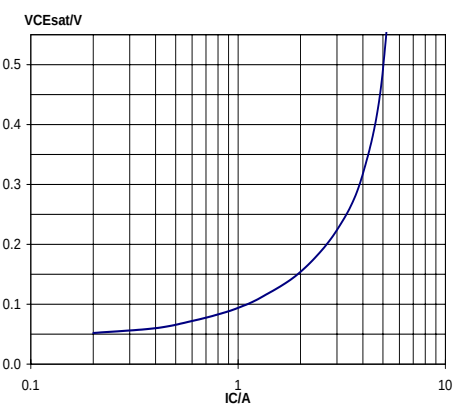


Fig. 11. Collector-Emitter saturation voltage.
 Solid lines = typ values, $V_{CE(sat)} = f(I_C)$; at $I_C/I_B = 4$.

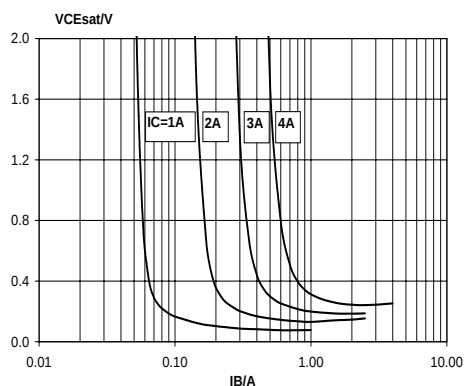


Fig. 9. Collector-Emitter saturation voltage.
 Solid lines = typ values, $V_{CE(sat)} = f(I_B)$; $T_j = 25^\circ C$

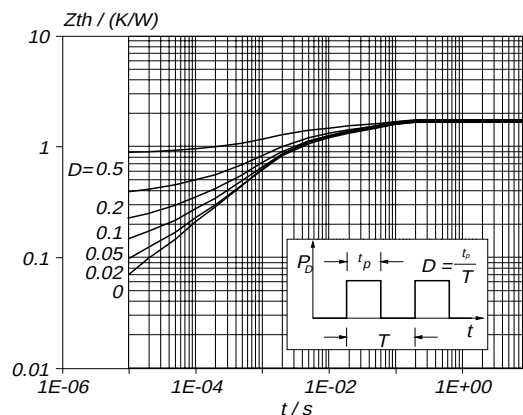
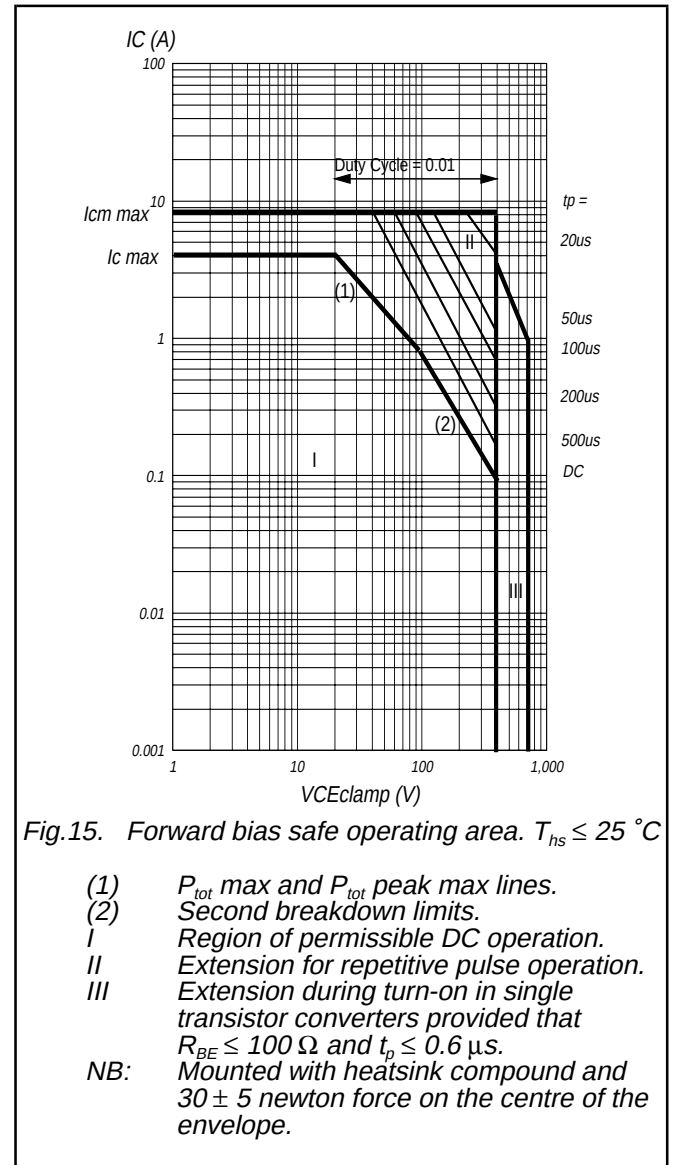
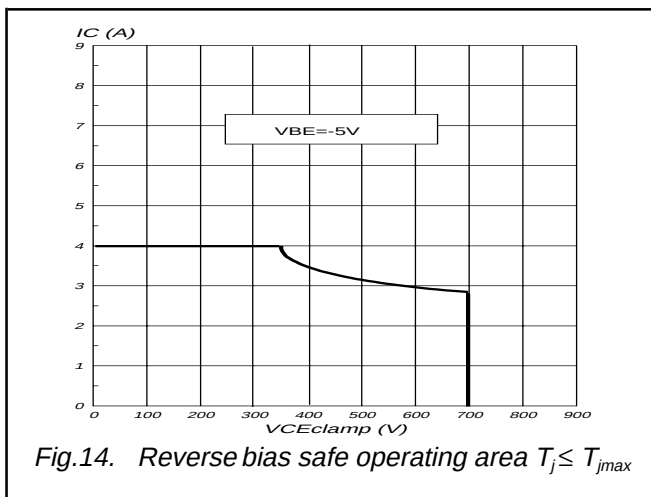
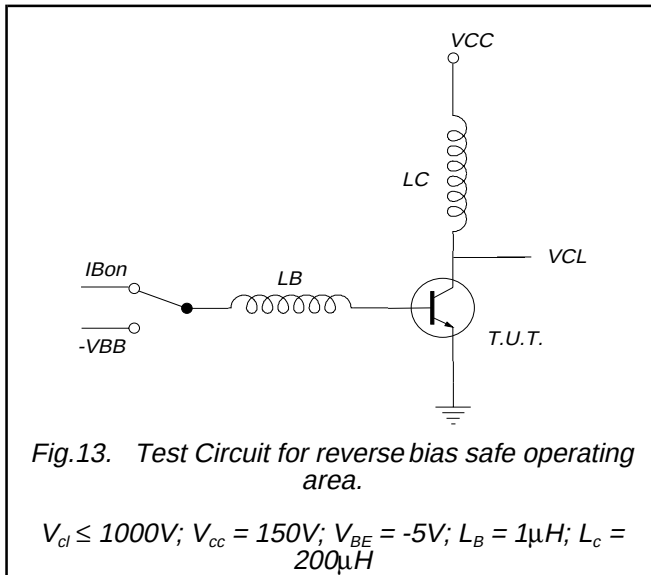


Fig. 12. Transient thermal impedance.

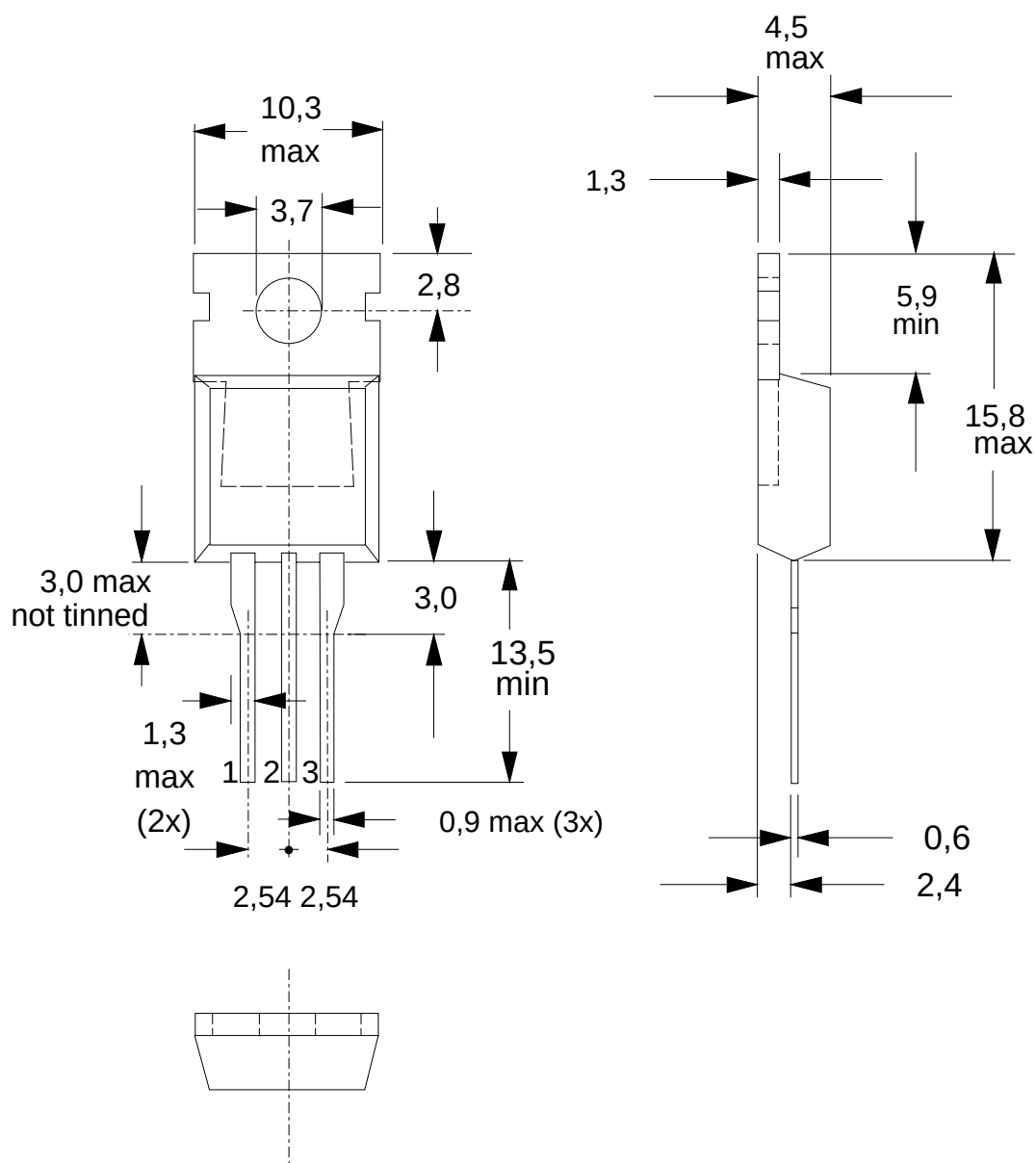


Fig.16. TO220AB; pin 2 connected to mounting base.
