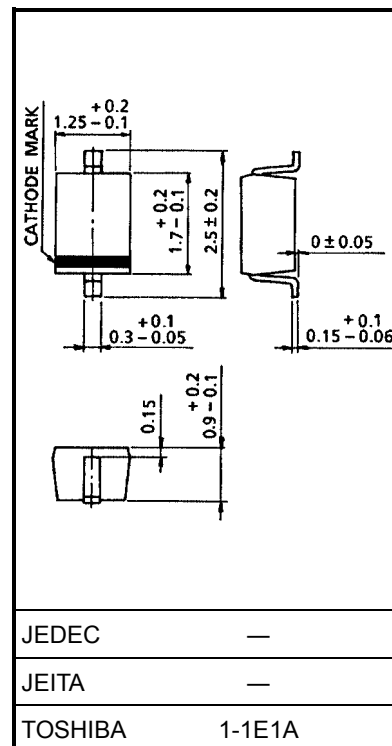
TV Tuning

- High capacitance ratio: $C2\text{ V}/C25\text{ V} = 6.5$ (typ.)
- Low series resistance: $r_s = 0.4\ \Omega$ (typ.)
- Excellent C-V characteristics, and small tracking error.
- Useful for small size tuner.
