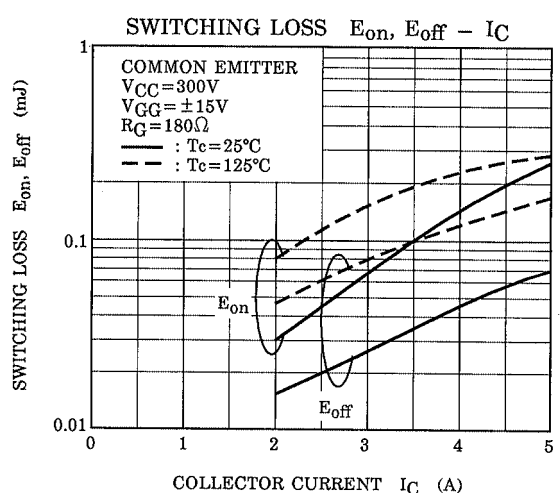
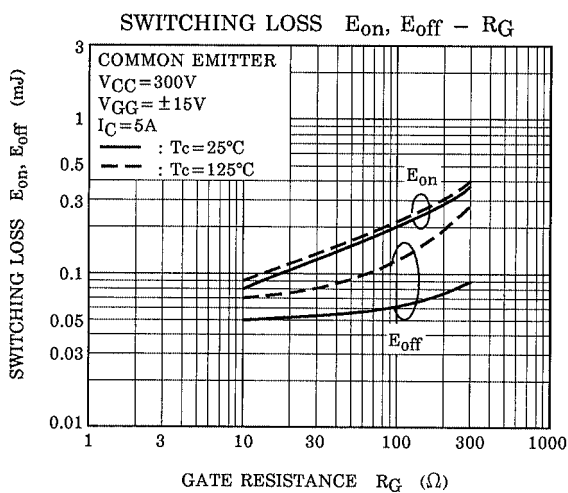
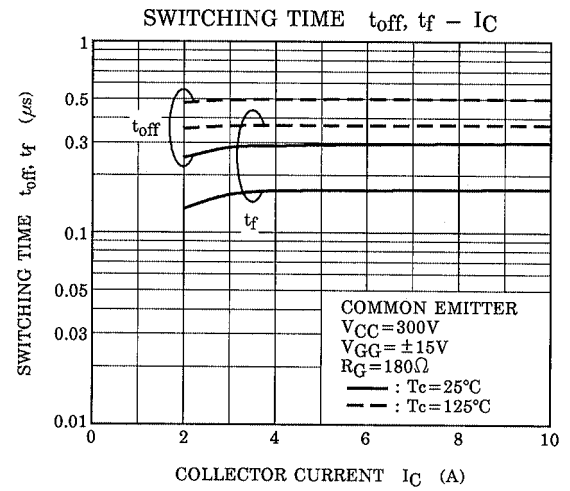
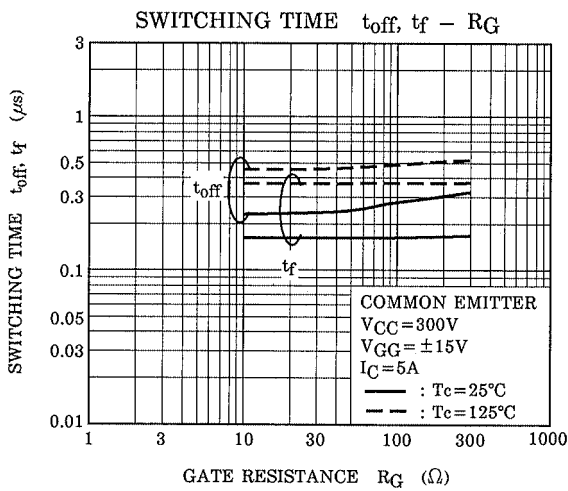
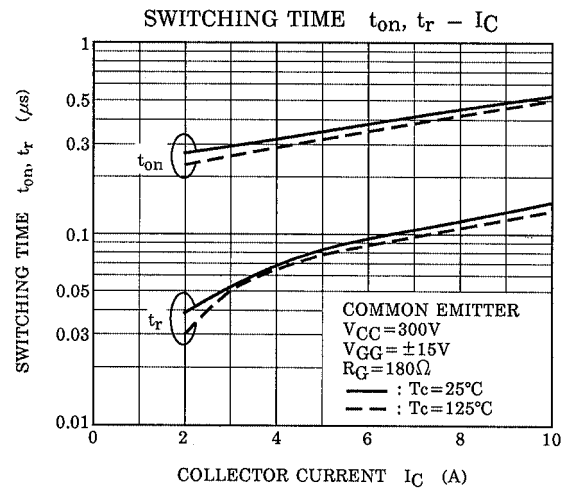
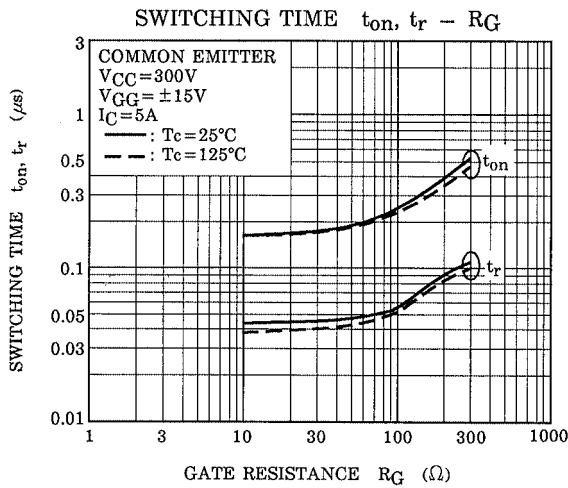
Note 1: Switching time measurement circuit and input / output waveforms

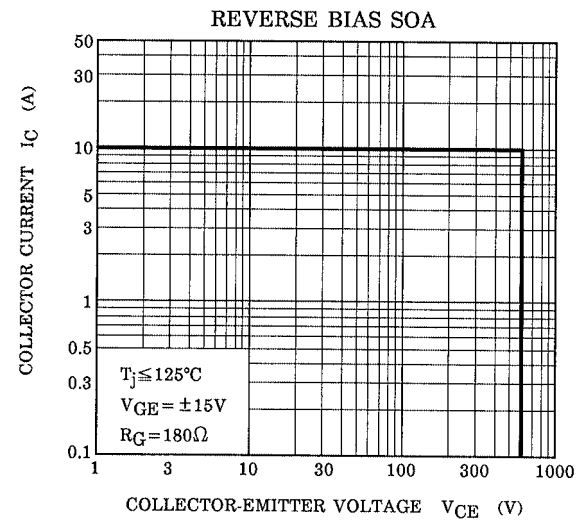
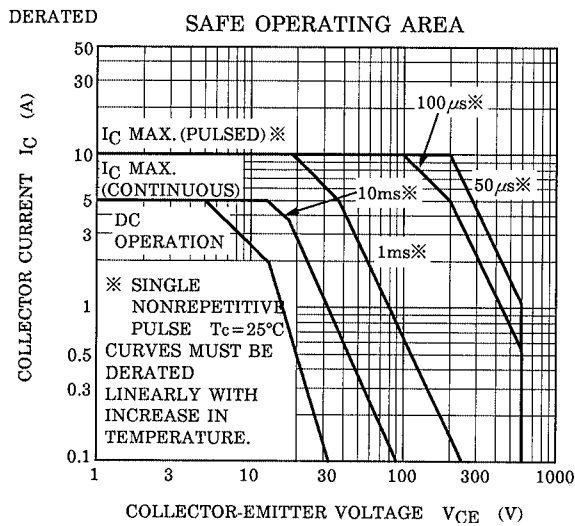
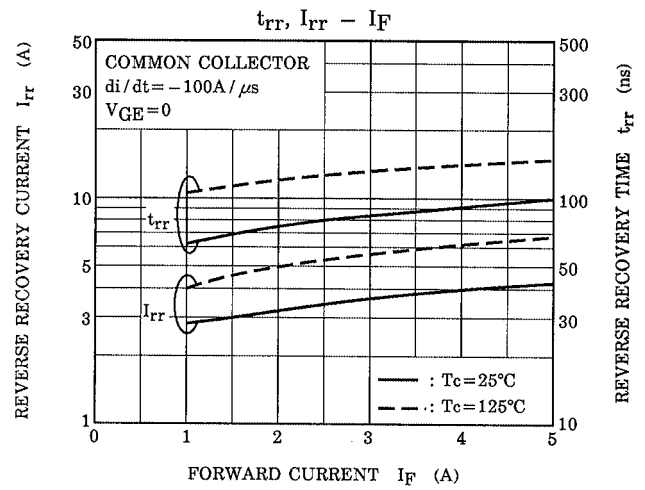
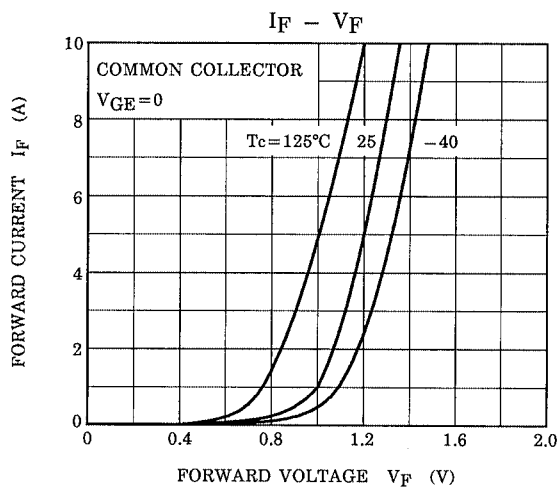
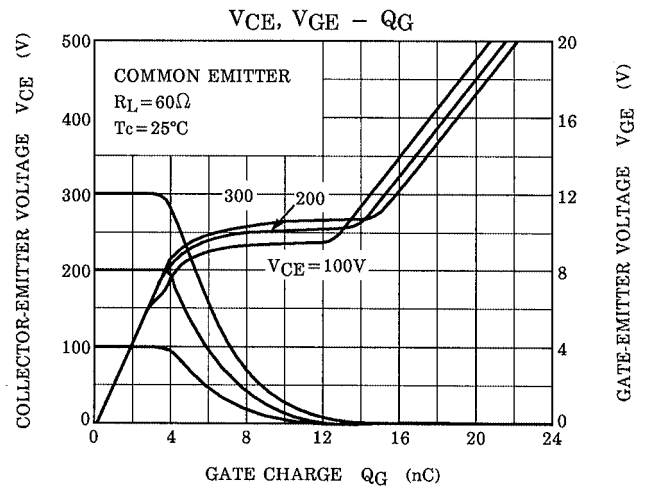
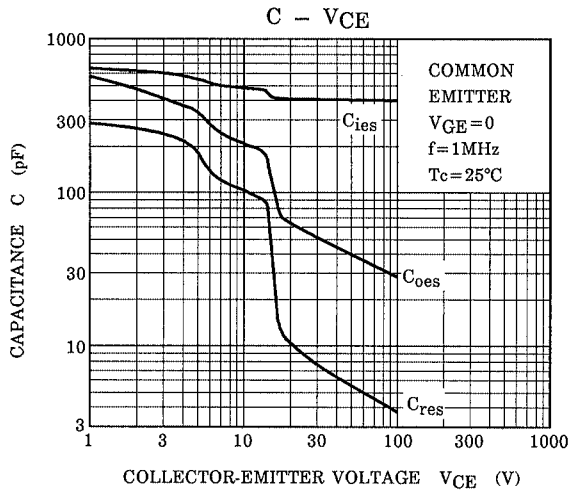


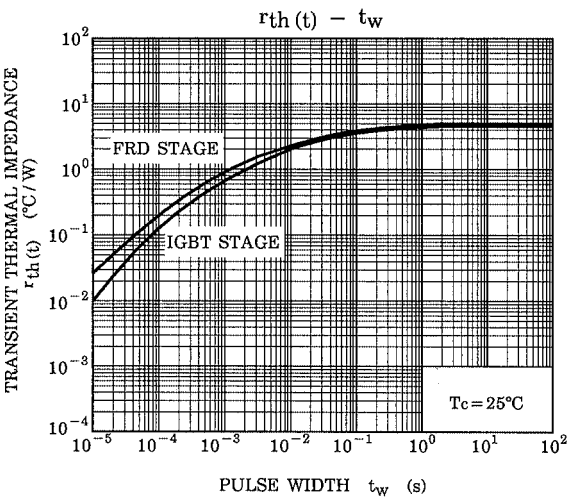
Switching loss measurement waveforms











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
