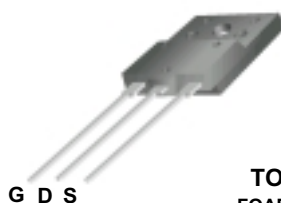
### General Description

These N-Channel enhancement mode power field effect transistors are produced using Fairchild's proprietary, planar stripe, DMOS technology.

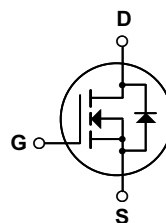

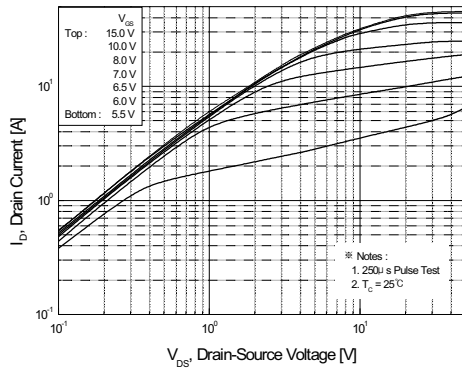


Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics

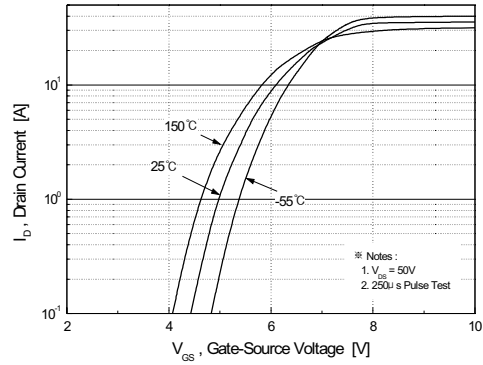


Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics

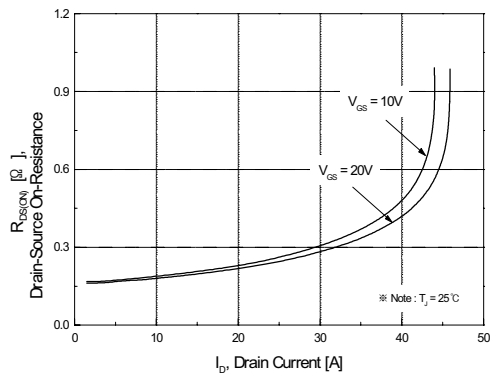


Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage

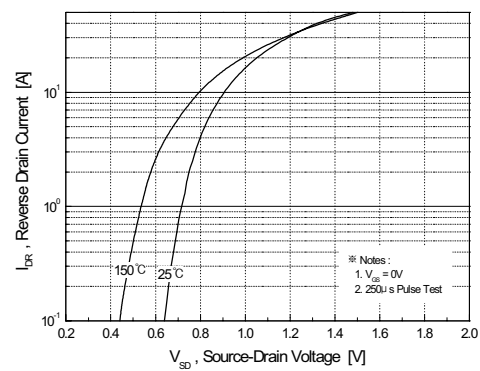


Figure 4. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation vs. Source Current and Temperature

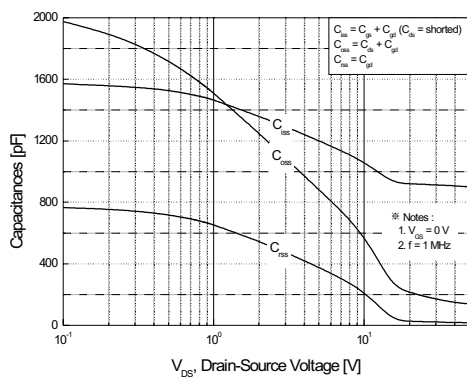


Figure 5. Capacitance Characteristics

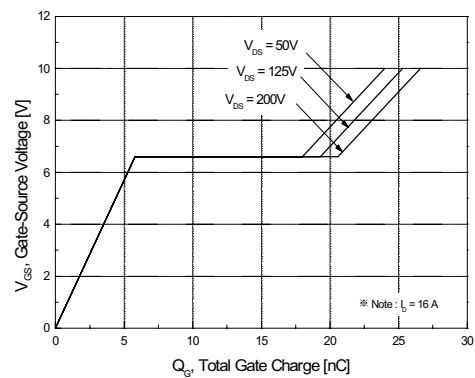
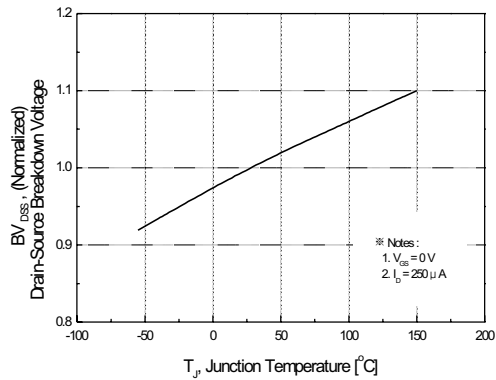
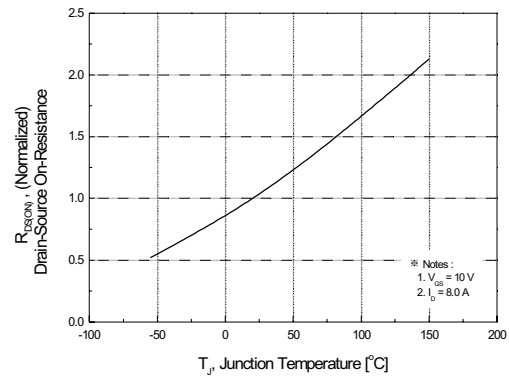


Figure 6. Gate Charge Characteristics

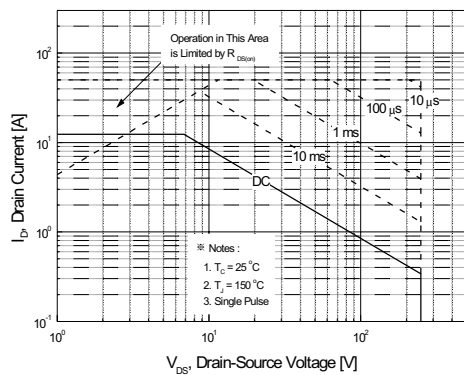

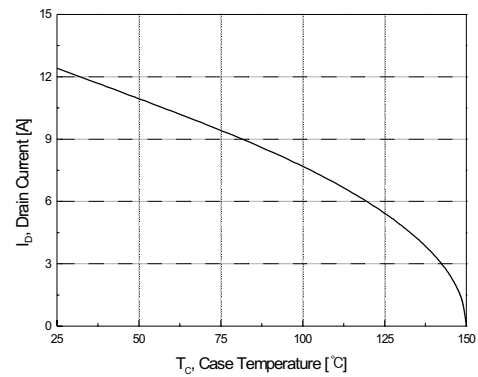
**Figure 7. Breakdown Voltage Variation vs. Temperature**



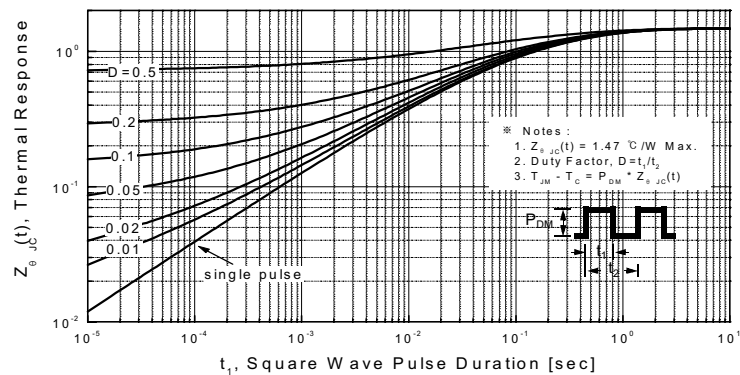
**Figure 8. On-Resistance Variation vs. Temperature**



**Figure 9. Maximum Safe Operating Area**

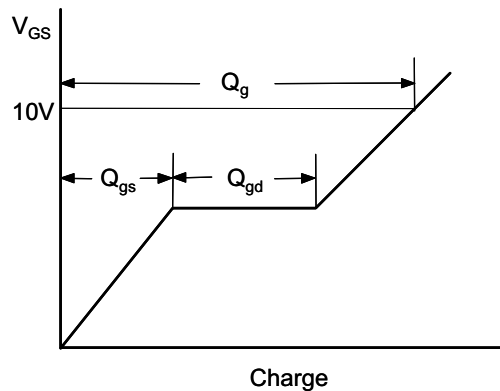
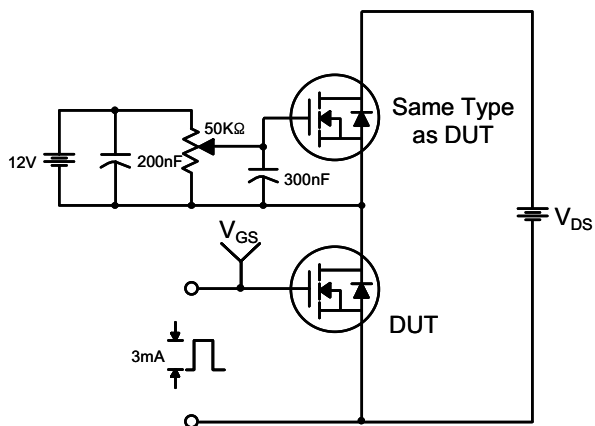


**Figure 10. Maximum Drain Current vs. Case Temperature**

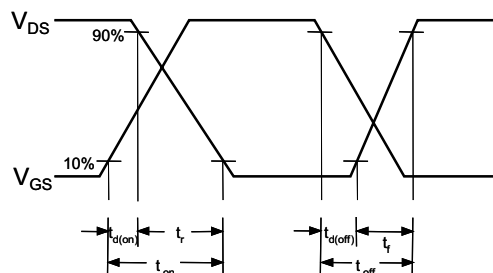
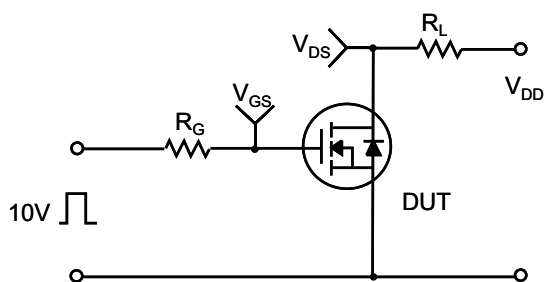


**Figure 11. Transient Thermal Response Curve**

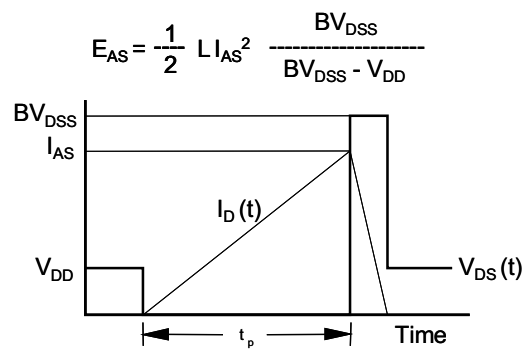
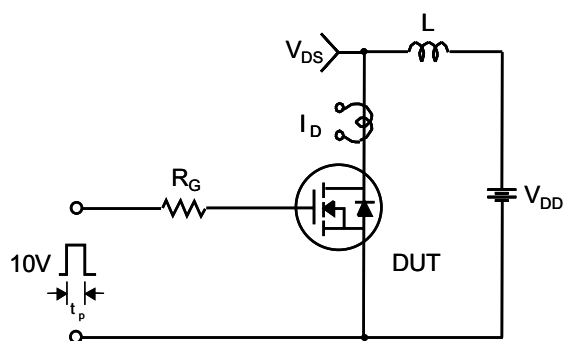
## Gate Charge Test Circuit &amp; Waveform



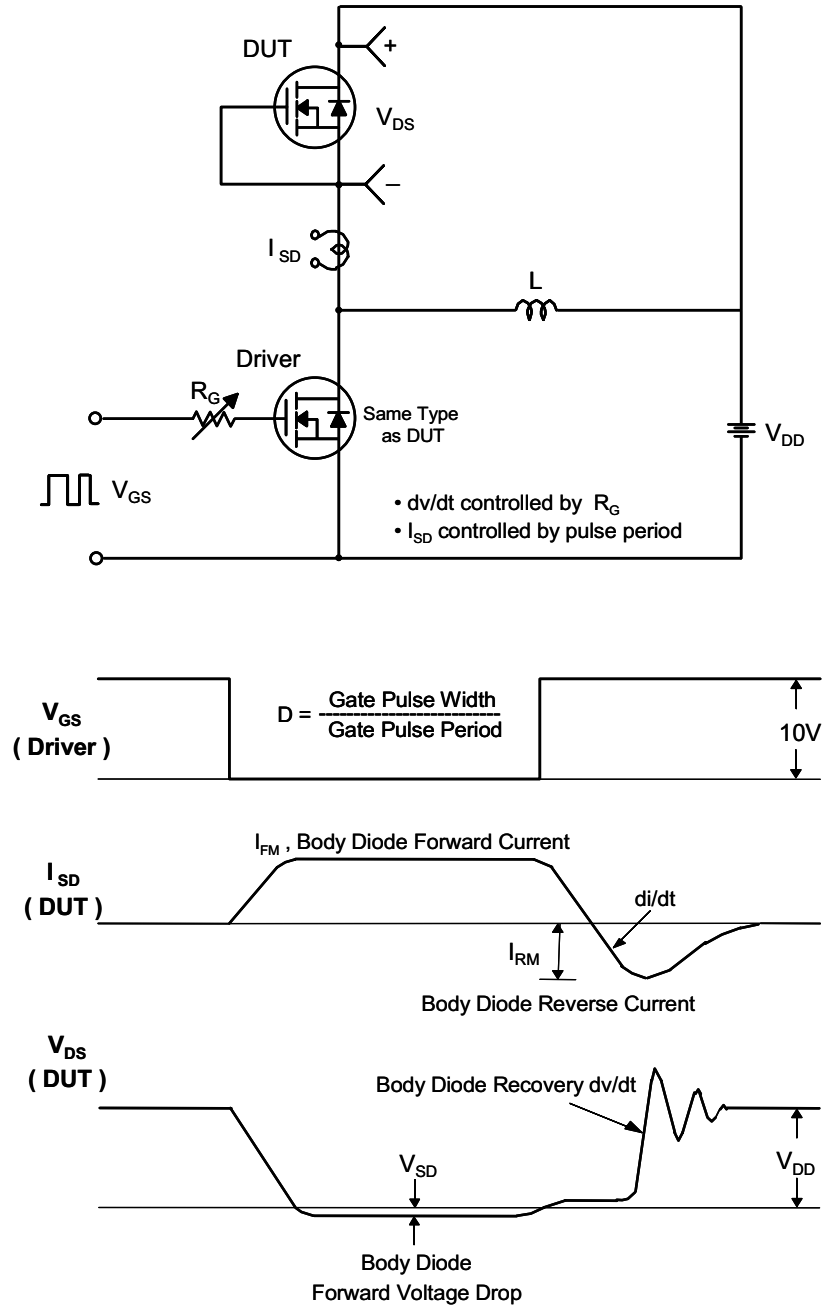
## Resistive Switching Test Circuit &amp; Waveforms



## Unclamped Inductive Switching Test Circuit &amp; Waveforms

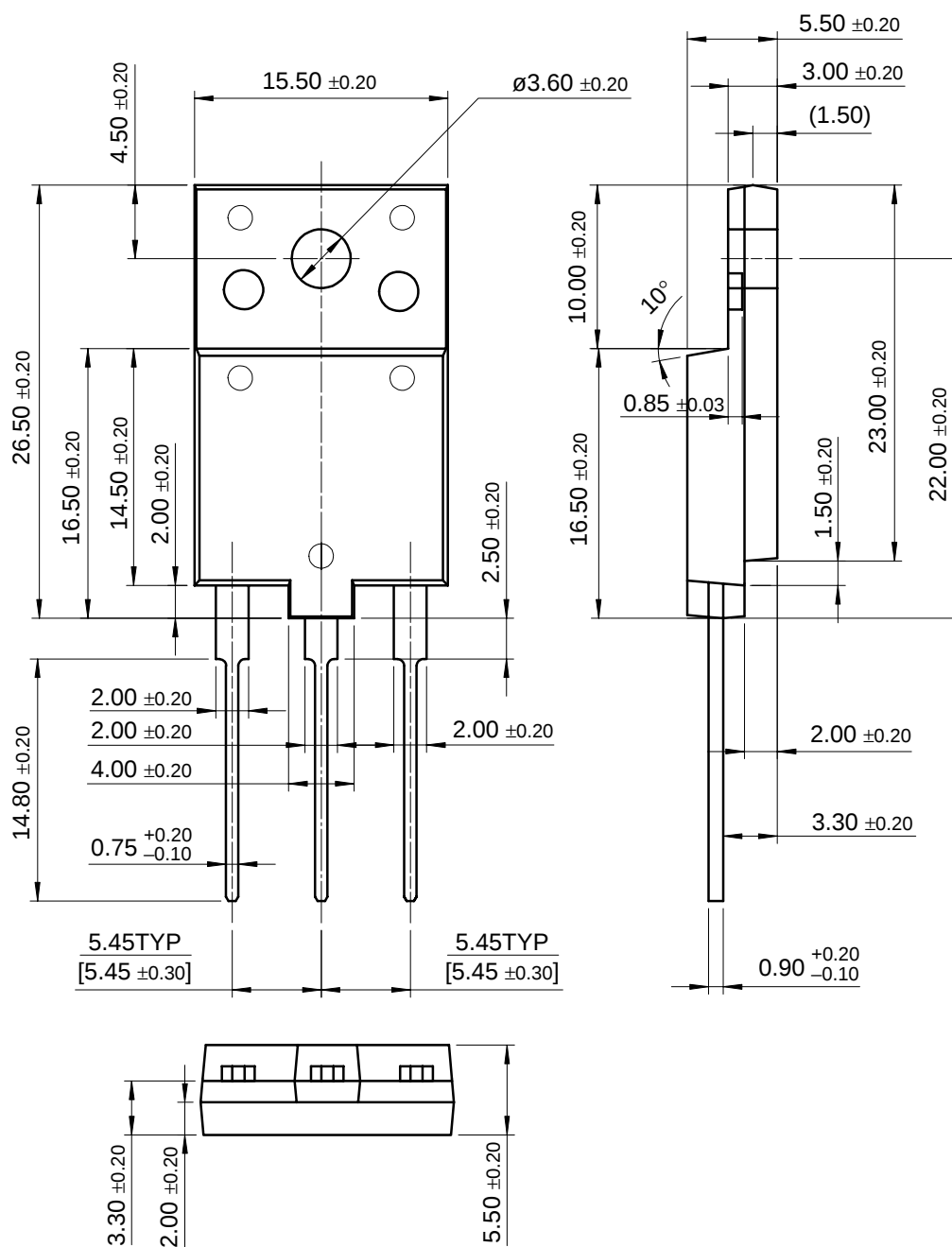


## Peak Diode Recovery dv/dt Test Circuit &amp; Waveforms
